Sponsors

Sponsors must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, and be 18 years of age. Training/orientation provided.

Do you pray regularly? Please consider taking on a special prayer request. The most important thing one can do for a friend in transition is to pray for them! Pray from your home, shower, car, office, wherever! People of all ages are needed, especially young adults and teens. Periodic card/letter writing to inquirer is requested.

Each year a concerted effort is made to capture the RCIA. Help us capture the experience for the participants. Pictures are taken at special events and of the group in general. Digital camera may be required.
