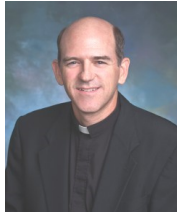

100th Anniversary Year of Our Lady of Fatima November 27, 2016–November 26, 2017 Indulgence Opportunities During the Centennial Anniversary of the Apparitions of Our Lady in Fatima, Portugal

Pope Francis has granted a plenary indulgence opportunity for the 100th anniversary of the Fatima apparitions throughout the centennial year, from the 27th of November 2016 till the 26th of November 2017. There are three ways to obtain the indulgence, detailed in a statement from the Fatima Shrine in Portugal (see below). To obtain the plenary indulgence, the faithful must also fulfill the ordinary conditions: go to Confession and Communion, be interiorly detached from sin, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.

1. **Make a pilgrimage to the Shrine in Fatima, Portugal:** To the faithful who make a pilgrimage to the Fatima Shrine in Portugal and participate in a celebration of prayer dedicated to the Virgin. In addition, the faithful must pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke the Mother of God.

2. **Pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima:** To the faithful who visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory or proper place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017, and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary. In addition, the faithful must pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.

3. **For the elderly and/or infirmed:** To the faithful who, because of age, illness or other serious cause, are unable to get around, may pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima and must spiritually unite themselves to the jubilee celebrations on the days of the apparitions, the 13th of each month, between May and October 2017. They must also *offer to merciful God with confidence, through Mary, their prayers and sufferings or the sacrifices they make in their own lives.*

Here at St. John's, we are blessed to have a beautiful outdoor grotto of Our Lady of Fatima. I am pleased to announce that Bishop Parkes has granted permission for us to make use of our grotto as a public place for veneration for the centennial anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady in Fatima, with the opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence as part of the second way: to visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima exposed for public veneration as part of some celebration during the days of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017.

With all this in mind, on the 13th of each month, from May through October, there will be two public gatherings to pray the rosary: one will be during the day (times will be announced) and one will be after sunset (the sunset rosary will be a candlelight service). Please mark your calendars and plan to be a part of this special grace-filled centennial anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady in Fatima.

Our first gathering at the Fatima grotto will be Saturday, May 13th at 10 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. Please note, the parking lot in front of the grotto will be roped off and not available to park your car. Please plan to use the other parking lots around the church for these events. Thank you.

In a future bulletin, we'll outline what a plenary indulgence is, how it is properly obtained, and for whom it can be obtained.

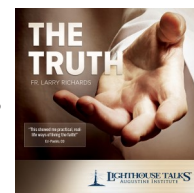

CROSSWALK SAFETY

Drivers! It's the Law!



When traffic signals are not present or not in operation, the driver of a vehicle must yield the right-of-way, slowing or stopping if necessary, to pedestrians crossing within a crosswalk upon the half of the roadway upon which the vehicle is traveling or when the pedestrian is approaching so closely from the opposite half of the roadway as to be in danger.

A driver may not overtake another driver stopped at a marked or unmarked crosswalk. (A pedestrian may be crossing in the crosswalk hidden from view by the stopped vehicle.)
