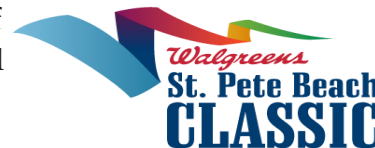

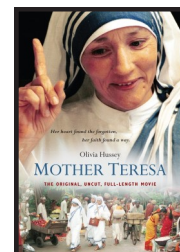

Heaven Starts Now, Becoming a Saint Day by Day by Fr. John Riccardo

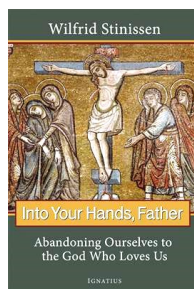

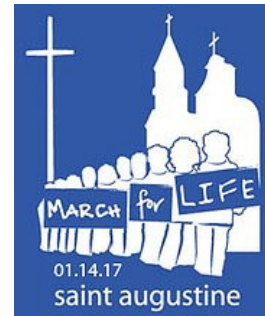

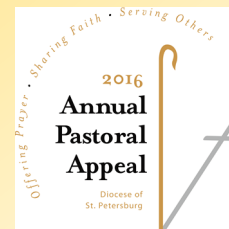
