### 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Year of Our Lady of Fatima November 27, 2016–November 26, 2017

Here at St. John's, we are blessed to have a beautiful outdoor grotto of Our Lady of Fatima. I am pleased to announce that Bishop Parkes has granted permission for us to make use of our grotto as a public place for veneration for the centennial anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady in Fatima, with the opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence as part of the second way: to visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima exposed for public veneration as part of some celebration during the days of the apparitions, the 13<sup>th</sup> of each month from May to October 2017.

With all this in mind, on the 13<sup>th</sup> of each month, from May through October, there will be two public gatherings to pray the rosary: one will be during the day (times will be announced) and one will be after sunset (the sunset rosary will be a candlelight service). **THE 50-DAYS OF FEASTING  
HOW TO LIVE IN EASTER JOY—MYSTAGOGY**

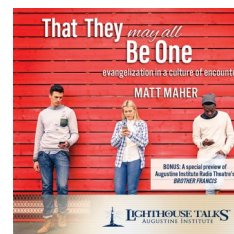
Neophyte (newly baptized) Catholics learn a spiritual practice called Mystagogy as part of their formation in the faith. Basically, Mystagogy *...is a time for the community and the neophytes to grow in deepening their grasp of the paschal mystery and in making it part of their lives...* Notice that this quote says the community and the neophytes. If you came to the liturgies of Holy Week and the Triduum, and even if you did not, now is the time to enter in to this reflective time of Mystagogy, both individually and as a community. What did you see, hear, smell or touch that was different at the Easter Mass? What passage of Scripture struck you as meant just for you? After the sparsity of Lent, how did it feel to enter a church full of flowers? Did the services on Good Friday resonate with your experience of loss or sacrifice? What was your gut reaction to watching our pastor kneel down to wash the feet of fellow parishioners? Now recall the sacramental signs of Easter: the waters of Baptism, the Bread of the Eucharist, the chrism oil of Confirmation, the fire of the New Paschal candle. Break open the mystery for yourself; don't just experience Easter Morning and then forget about it. We have 50 days of the Easter Season to reflect: What does this all mean? That's Mystagogy! For all of us!

**CROSSWALK SAFETY**

Drivers! It’s the Law!

When traffic signals are not present  
or not in operation, the driver of a  
vehicle must yield the right-of-way,  
slowing or stopping if necessary, to pedestrians  
crossing within a crosswalk upon the half of the  
roadway upon which the vehicle is traveling or  
when the pedestrian is approaching so closely  
from the opposite half of the roadway as to be in  
danger.



A driver may not overtake another driver stopped  
at a marked or unmarked crosswalk. (A pedestri-  
an may be crossing in the crosswalk hidden from  
view by the stopped vehicle.)

The Enthronement of the Sacred Heart in the family is recognition of Jesus as King of the family.

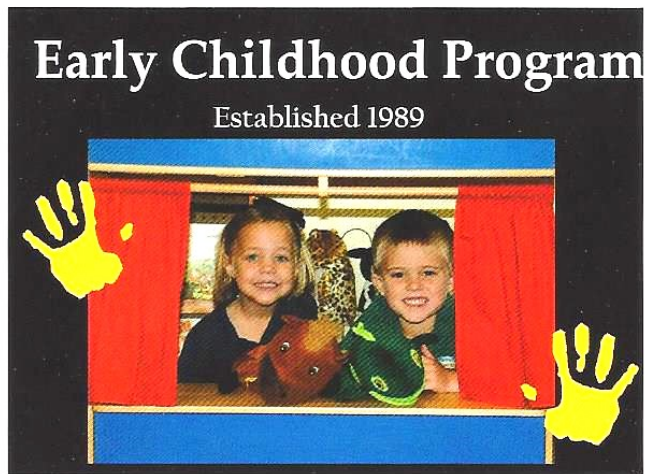
